Health Care & Disaster Relief

Jacob's Well provides periodic weeklong health care clinics. Since the beginning of our ministry, we have been involved in most of the crises to help people in need. Our disaster relief help has involved giving food, water, shelter, health care, solar lighting and counseling. We have also provided prefab houses and the rebuilding of a church chapel after the natural disasters that have demolished lives, homes and property all over Haiti.

Education & Community Development

Jacob's Well ministry offers adult education with classes in basic literacy and writing. We encourage and support single mothers in returning to school and young adults pursuing a higher education or attending a ministry school. We are partners with Food for the Poor to help build houses for those in need. Also, since the Gospel is light, we demonstrate that truth by providing solar powered kits for homes to replace the kerosene lamps that are a source of fires and some eye and lung diseases. Sanitation is a major health hazard and we have provided more than 200 sanitary latrines that saved the lives of many during cholera outbreaks.



Youth & Sports Camp

Haiti's future is its people. Investing in the younger generation is the most strategic way to shape the nation's future. We partner with U.S. camps and churches to help with Vacation Bible School, Children and Youth Camps. Our developing ministry in Sports Camp has a goal to build two soccer fields and one sport court that will serve basketball, volleyball and tennis for youth and also develop coaches and referees. In addition to the opportunity for evangelism, we hope that the sport program will be a gateway to economic opportunities for the younger generation.
