The Gospel is Spreading



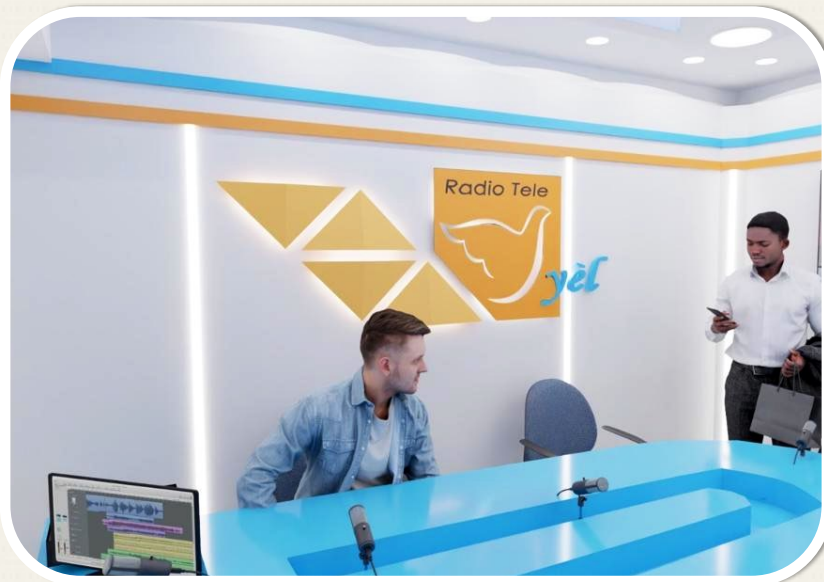

TO INFINITY AND BEYOND

Radio has been a vital part of our ministry since 2013 when we first launched our radio station CIEL FM 98.7 at Jacob's Well. We started humbly with a 14 Watt transmitter. We've now grown into a regional radio station with approximately 1 million listeners. We are now on the brink of going international with our new production studio in Port-au-Prince.

The establishment of a production studio in Port-au-Prince allows us to leverage the Internet and tap into the wealth of talent available in the capital city. Our goal is to create high-quality Christian content that can be utilized by other medias to enhance their daily programming. In light of the current crisis in the country, Internet radio stands as one of the most effective ways to connect people and we hope to use it to spread the gospel.



Our new studio is now fully operational and we are in the process of recruiting talented individuals who will help us elevate our work to a new level. One of our main challenges is securing the financial resources needed to support them for one year as we will need \$1,500 per month. Among our recruits are Vanessa, a mother with experience in Christian broadcasting and Wesley, a father with a similar background.

While we still have our physical radio station at Jacob's Well, the new studio will produce quality content to be rebroadcast over the Internet to be available to French-speaking people worldwide. Our goal is to ensure that our radio remains competitive! Please pray and explore ways of how you can partner with us to reach this new level!



RENEWAL AT THE VILLAGE CHURCH



Challenges, Prayers and Victory

The Village Church (Port-au-Prince) has been our primary focus this year. We were forced to stay in Port-au-Prince and concentrate on the church versus traveling to Jacob's Well as it was too dangerous. We planted the Village Church eight years ago and from day one this church has been self-supported financially. But now because of the civil war in the country and the gang activities in the capital city, we were not able to generate enough resources to meet the \$6,000 needed monthly to financially operate the ministry.

This crisis provides the opportunity to renew the congregation and rebuild the ministry and we have seen more people coming to Christ and being baptized than we have seen in the last eight years. Almost every Sunday we conduct believer's baptism in our morning service. This form of worship attracts more and more people, but the newcomers are not yet committed to supporting the church financially. Pray for us this fall and the financial resources that are needed.



STORMING THE GATE OF VOODOO



144,000 Preachers to Storm the Nation

In the Book of Revelation, we learn about the 144,000 servants of God who will serve Christ during the tribulation era. Inspired by this, we aim to initiate a similar movement in our generation by equipping a team of preachers to spread the gospel in our nation. We see the current crisis as a unique opportunity to establish house churches as people are staying in their neighborhoods for safety reasons. We have already trained the first group of 10 students, who are actively preaching.

Our goal for this year is to recruit and train 40 more students to be ready to engage with their communities next year. As this movement grows, we anticipate a revival of interest in Bible study and transformation in the lives of those involved. New Marching Band in Ti Guinea

Our community impact efforts have reached a new milestone as the sound of the new marching band fills the air with the tune of "Onward Christian Soldier." The staff at Jacob's Wells has begun to equip village children with musical skills, and the parents are very supportive. The village now boasts its own marching band!

This marks the beginning of a positive transformation in the village. Previously, the only instruments available were drums and handmade bamboo instruments. Now, the culture will be enriched with new sounds, providing greater opportunities for children to learn formal music. We are grateful for our dedicated staff and ask for prayers for musical instruments to support their work.
